

# PATRICK CÔTÉ

multidisciplinary artist & public personality



Born in the small village of Saint-Narcisse-de-Rimouski on February 29, 1980, Patrick Côté spent 15 years as a professional mixed martial arts (MMA) fighter, including a glorious career within the prestigious UFC organization, where he competed in a world championship. He holds a black belt in Brazilian jiu-jitsu.

At 19, in 1999, while searching for meaning in his life, Patrick joined the Canadian Army, where he learned discipline and determination. During this period, he was introduced to mixed martial arts and also took up judo and boxing. In 2002, he completed a mission in Bosnia as an armored vehicle driver, helping to rebuild the country and assist the local population. He describes this experience as one of those that defined who he is today.

In 2004, Patrick Côté left the army and began dedicating himself more seriously and diligently to competitive sports when he joined Team Union in Quebec City. Always involved in high-level sports, Patrick was the first Quebecer to compete on the prestigious Ultimate Fighting Championship (UFC) stage, where he devoted himself fully to reaching the highest peaks. Notably, he is the Canadian with the most fights in the UFC.



After achieving remarkable victories and still at the peak of his form with an impressive record of 23 wins in 34 fights, he announced his retirement live at the end of a televised fight seen worldwide in 2017, to dedicate himself to his daughter and to mentoring the many up-and-coming fighters seeking his guidance.

Armed with an impressive wealth of experience, Patrick has been the official French-speaking voice of the UFC since April 19, 2008. In this role, he appears on RDS alongside host Jean-Paul Chartrand Jr., covering all UFC events and fights. He also provides the same commentary worldwide when these events are broadcast on pay-per-view channels. Naturally, Patrick Côté regularly acts as a sports commentator on various shows in Quebec City and Montreal.

Appreciated on the sets where he appears, he continues to accumulate roles.
